4. Print the Play-a-thon Letter to Parents and distribute it to your students.
5. Print the Play-a-thon Sponsor Sheet for each student, so that they may begin collecting donations and sponsors.
6. Music does not have to be memorized, but it should be of performance-ready quality.
7. Students may play classical, pop, holiday, or duet music.
8. ***Applications (Piano Play-a-thon Registration Form) can now be filled in on-line at www.cfmta.net.** Then print out the form and mail with **one check** from each teacher, made payable to CFMTA for the total amount of donations collected to date.
9. Please DO NOT have students send checks individually to chairperson.
