The Annual Student Competition is a highly competitive event, with prize money awarded to 1st and 2nd place winners. This competition is open to students of all CFMTA members in good standing.

1. Each teacher may enter as many students as he/she desires.
2. There is no maximum performance time limit, but the number of entrants at each level will determine the time allotted for each student. The judge(s) has the discretion to ask the student to stop after a reasonable time, if the number of contestants requires it.
3. If three or fewer entries are received for any level, then that level will be cancelled for this year's competition -- **a minimum of 4 entries is required for each level.**
4. Teacher whose students are competing may be asked to volunteer on site.
5. Students must perform **at least two** compositions of contrasting styles.
6. First, second, and third place winners from each level will perform at the Winners Recital.
7. ***Applications (Student Event Registration Form) can now be filled in on-line at www.cfmta.net.** Then print out the form and mail with **one check** from each teacher, made payable to CFMTA for the total amount of student fees.
8. **Once submitted, the student's program may not be altered or the performance will not be heard.**
