

District V Honors Audition Guidelines

The purpose of the Honors Audition is to select 5 qualified students from each Local Association to perform in the Honors Recital at the FSMTA District V One Day Conference, to be held on March 7, 2009 at the University of Central Florida.

1. Participants

- Each performer must be chosen through competitive auditions, with a qualified judge making the selection.
- Any student, at any age level through High School, may participate.
- Auditions are closed-door (no audience).
- Participants may leave after their scheduled audition, and will be notified of the outcome by their teacher.
- Please note: Teachers whose students are chosen to perform at the Honors Recital must pay the registration fee for the District Conference, even if they are unable to attend.

2. Composition:

- Students may perform ONE composition (or two shorter pieces).
- Time: NOT to exceed 6 minutes (exception: Judge's choice of an advanced student playing a selection that may require SLIGHTLY more time.)
- ALL solo performances must be from memory. Ensemble teams (duets, trios, quartets) may use music. Concertos are not allowed in this Audition.
- NO solo transcriptions, simplified, or abridged editions are allowed.
- Students may NOT perform the same selection in subsequent years.
- Only the judge's choice of student and composition may be performed at the Honors Recital.

- **Application fee: \$10.00 per student**
- **Application deadline: February 7, 2009**
