

Non-Competitive Events Guidelines

- Applications for CFMTA events can be found on the Applications link of this site.
- All non-competitive student events are open to the public.
- CFMTA student events are open to students of all members in good standing.
- Students are **REQUIRED** to check in with the Event Chairperson 15 minutes prior to the event or the student will forfeit the opportunity to perform.
- Students may perform the same work within a given year. They may not perform the same work for the same event in subsequent years.
- All solo performances must be from memory; ensemble performers may use their music.
- The use of any audiotaping or video taping equipment during a recital or competitive event is prohibited. (This statement should appear on all local and district programs.)
- **NO** transcriptions (unless considered part of the standard repertoire and previously approved by the CFMTA Musicologist) or simplified editions may be used.
- **DEADLINES:** All applications must be postmarked by the printed deadline.
- Chairperson and Co-Chairpersons may submit their own students in all competitive and non-competitive activities.

Teachers: Please note that YOU are responsible for your students meeting the various requirements of each event.
