

CFMTA Sonatina & Sonata Festival: COVID Addendum

Procedures & Precautions: All participants (including performers, performer's family members, teachers, volunteers, and judge) will be asked to wear masks while indoors.

Registration will be held outdoors to allow for more space to congregate while social distancing. Temperatures will be checked for all participants and volunteers at registration.

Performers will be asked to wash their hands prior to using the piano.

In the competition space, the judge will be seated more than 6 feet away from the performer at all times.

Virtual Participation: For those not comfortable performing live, a virtual "zoom" audition will be possible for the 2021 Sonatina & Sonata Festival.

Students will perform via zoom for the judge during their assigned timeslot. A zoom link and further zoom instructions (camera set-up, audio suggestions, etc) will be distributed when the schedule is sent out. Students will be required to submit a PDF of their score for the judge in advance. All standard requirements such as memorization will apply.

All zoom auditions will be screen recorded to be used in the virtual recital should the contestant be the division winner, so all students participating virtually will need to submit a photo/video release form.

Recital: In lieu of holding a live Winner's Recital, CFMTA will record each student's performance. The winner's performance from each round will be compiled to create a virtual recital which will be streamed. All participants will be required to submit a photo/video release form.

Time Limits: Time limits for repertoire performed for the judge will be waived this year. Students may play their entire selection, but without any repeats.
